GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 15-2017 1ST READING

An Ordinance authorizing the City of Marion, Indiana, to make temporary loans to meet current running expenses for the use of the General Fund, the Parks and Recreation Fund, the Aviation/Airport Fund, the Motor Vehicle Highway Fund, the City Debt Service Fund, the Park Bond Fund and the Cumulative Capital Development Fund of the Issuer, in anticipation of and not in excess of current taxes levied in the year 2017, and collectable in the year 2018; authorizing the issuance of temporary loan tax anticipation warrants to evidence such loans and the sale of such warrants to the Indiana Bond Bank; and appropriating and pledging the taxes to be received in such funds to the punctual payment of such warrants including the interest thereon.
